The program is opening applications for all students interested in preparing themselves for the most elite careers in financial services, who can commit the necessary time for all projects and who can keep up with the intensity of the hands-on, real-world investment decisions and global challenges you will be facing as a member of the program. A significant time commitment is necessary to excel, as well as a strong interest in the field.

Technical Learning Opportunities: Students build and develop the necessary technical modeling skills for the financial services sector while improving presentation and communication skills applicable to any industry.

Early Career Preparation: This Program helps prepare students for careers in equity research, investment banking, private equity, quantitative hedge funds, and asset management (avg. graduate starting salary ~\$95,000).
