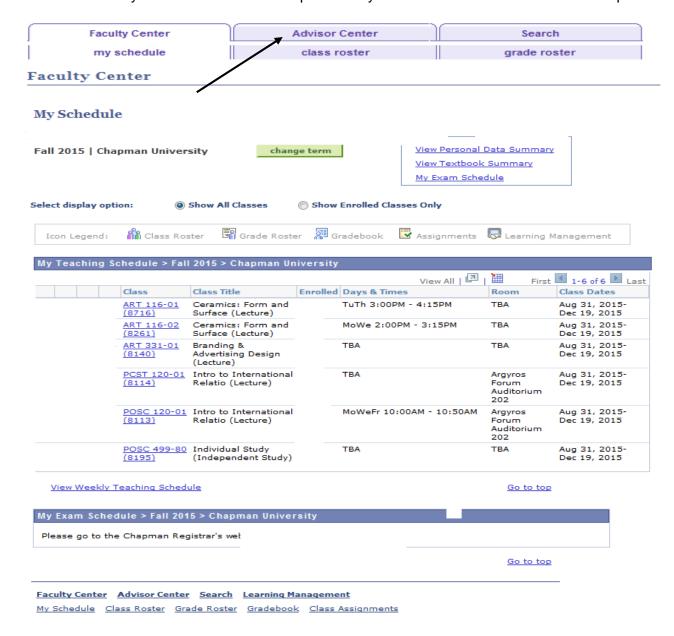
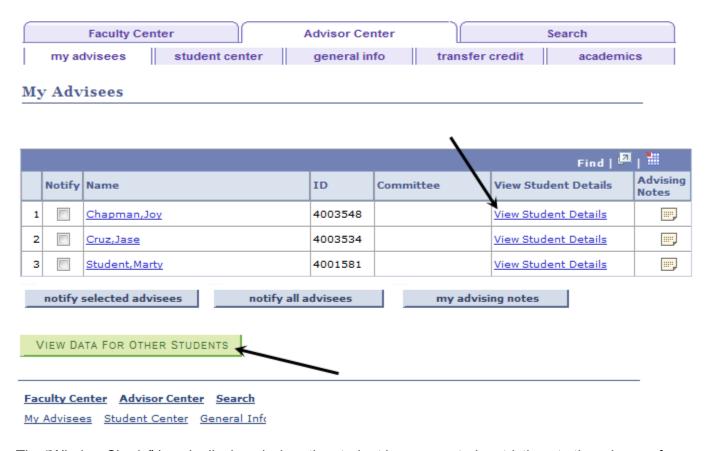
REFERENCE GUIDE TO ENROLLMENT REPORTS IN ADVISOR CENTER MY.CHAPMAN.EDU

1. If you are Faculty in addition to an Advisor, the Faculty Center click on the Advisor Center tab. If you are not Faculty the Advisor Center will open when you enter the Advisor Center from the portal.



2. The Advisor Center opens to the My Advisees tab. Students who are assigned to you as their Advisor will display. Click on the <u>View Student Details</u> link to see the student's schedule and access reports. You may also click the "View Data for Other Students" link to access information for other students.



The "Window Shade" icon is displayed when the student has requested restrictions to the release of personal information. It is referred to as the FERPA flag.

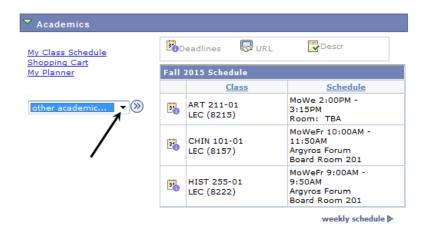


3. There are multiple tabs in the Advisor Center. A brief description of each tab is below:



- My Advisees This section will display the names of students who have been assigned by the
 academic departments to a faculty member for advising. Full-time faculty will also have access to
 other students for advising.
- **Student Center** This section is an abbreviated version of the student version of the Student Center. The data not displayed is the Finance section which provides information from Student Accounts and Financial Aid.
- **General Info** This section displays similar information contained on the Student Center in a different format. Additional demographic data is also displayed.
- Transfer Credit Summary information on the institution and units are displayed on this tab.
 Clicking the Detail link opens a PeopleSoft window with course detail. Click the OK button to return to the Advisor Center.
- Academics This tabs displays students' academic career and program plan data in additional to details for each term.

4. Advisee Student Center - Academics



The following reports can be accessed from the drop down menu under "other academic . . ."

- Converted Enrollment Summary (unofficial historical data unofficial transcript)
- Course History
- Transfer Credit Report
- Program Evaluation (available later in Summer)

Other reports may be available in the future. . Some reports will open as a PDF, others will open a new page in PeopleSoft and others will display in the current screen.

Converted Enrollment Summary

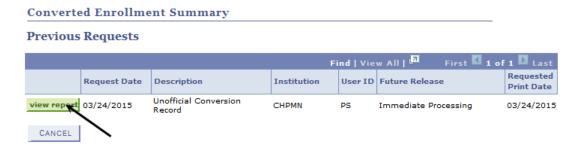
To open this report – select it from the drop down menu and click the double arrows.

To return to the Advisee Student Center, click the Cancel button at the bottom of the page.



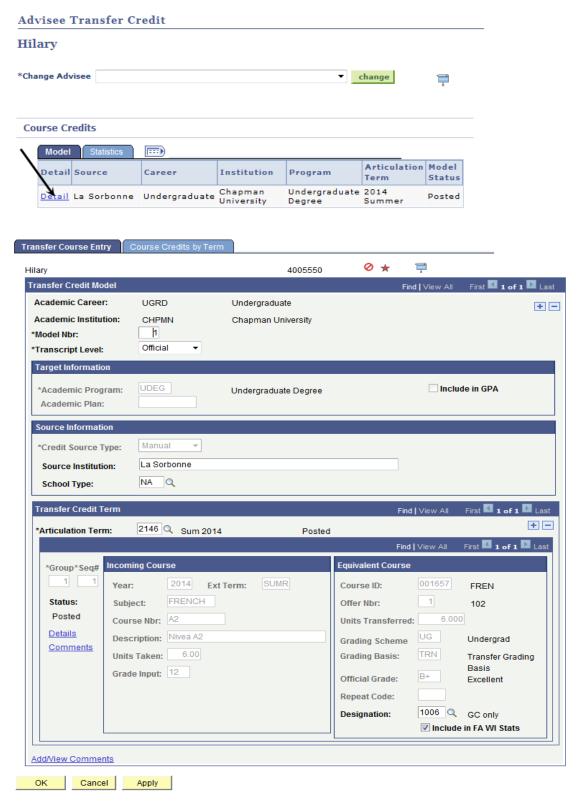
Transfer Credit Report
