

## Requirements Checklist for the Preliminary Speech-Language Pathology Credential

The Communication Sciences and Disorders (CSD) Graduate Department is accredited by the Council on Academic Accreditation in Audiology and Speech-Language Pathology (CAA) in speech-language pathology. Graduate students who complete the Master of Science degree are prepared for entry-level speech-language pathology positions in schools, medical and other employment settings.

Students must meet all of the graduation requirements, and these requirements are in line with the knowledge, the skills and professional aspects that meet the accreditation standards of CAA and competencies outlined by CTC.

- All requirements have been met using the CTC/ASHA Crosswalk Matrix checklist
- Master of Science degree has been conferred by the Office of the Registrar on August 1
- Student must complete and submit a request form to be recommended for the Preliminary Speech-Language Pathology Credential
- The credential authorized submitter has received the following documents:
  - TB Test Results
  - CBEST Score Report
  - Certificate of Clearance
  - Final Transcript

Graduate students who have met all of these requirements can be recommended for a Preliminary Speech-Language Pathology Credential.
