
## Centralized Application Service for Communication Science and Disorders Programs (CSDCAS)

The master-of-science degree in Communication Sciences and Disorders (CSD) prepares students to become fully credentialed and licensed speech language pathologists, clinicians and/or supervisors in healthcare and education settings. This full-time, intensive program is a rich combination of didactic and clinical/fieldwork courses providing carefully guided internships each semester. Placements include hospitals, skilled nursing facilities, private practice, agencies, early intervention programs, and K-12 public schools. Students have both on-site supervisors and university supervisors assigned for each setting.

### **Application Process**

The entire application process for Chapman University's M.S Communication Sciences and Disorders is completed through the Communication Sciences and Disorders Centralized Application System (CSDCAS)

Fall 2019 Application Cycle will open on: August 2, 2018

#### Deadline to submit your application to CSDCAS: January 15, 2019 at 11:59pm Eastern Standard Time

The admissions committee only reviews applications that are submitted and verified. This means that all items required (see below) must be submitted and verified by CSDCAS by the January 15 deadline. The verification process turn around time increases during the months of December -February and may take up to four weeks.

Please turn everything in early to avoid any delays in the application reviewing process

- \*Chapman University does not require a supplemental application
- \*There are no additional application fees. You only need to pay the CSDCAS application fee.

#### Required documents include:

- · Official Transcripts for all schools attended -Sent directly to CSDCAS
- Official GRE scores Test scores sent directly to CSDCAS (Chapman's GRE Code:0690)
  Personal Statement This is included in the CSDCAS Application
- Three Letters of Recommendation Forms are included in the CSDCAS Application
