- ALL science prerequisite courses must be designed for science majors and include a lab.
- Anatomy & Physiology must be completed within 5 years of application submission.
- All other prerequisite courses must be completed within 10 years of application submission.
- Prerequisite courses may be repeated only once. The AVERAGE of both courses to be used for GPA calculation.
- No prerequisite grade below "C" is considered.
- · Pass/Credit grades for prerequisite courses will be accepted and if letter grading options are available please submit them.
- Courses which received advanced placement credit (AP or CLEP) may fulfill prerequisite requirements.
 - The credit hours and grade points will not be computed in the GPA calculation.
- · No more than two science prerequisite courses and one human behavior or statistics prerequisite course (a total of three prerequisite courses) may be remaining after application is submitted.
- ALL in progress prerequisite course work must be completed before the program starts.
