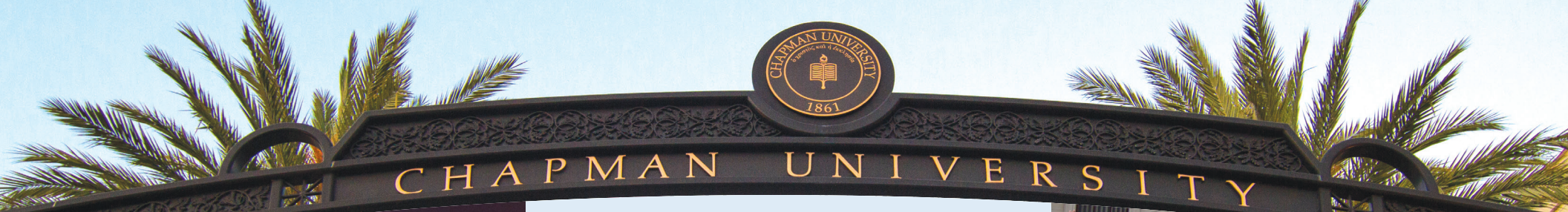

The minor requires a total of 21 credits, including the following core courses:

- HUM 205:** Introduction to Gay/Lesbian/Bisexual/Transgender/Queer Studies (3 credits)
- IES 310:** Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, and Questioning Issues in Education (3 credits)
- PSY 344:** Gay, Lesbian, and Bisexual Psychology (3 credits)
